The Kigezi Orphans Project, founded in 2012 and located in the southwestern highlands of Uganda, primarily aims to support orphans and other vulnerable people and strives to lead them into an independent future by providing them with solid basic training.

The focus of the efforts is the Kigezi Community School, which was fully licensed by the Ministry of Education in 2021.

Since its founding, over 1,400 girls and 950 boys have benefited from the great support. More than 400 students are currently looked after, of which around 200 orphans live locally. Makeshift classrooms have to serve as temporary accommodation. Unmistakable signals indicate that the number of children will increase quickly. Those responsible are faced with enormous demands.

Larger, medium-term projects must be started and financed locally.
